

- Retail sales expected to rise this holiday season. The National Retail Federation expects retail sales to grow by as much as 4% or at least match the 3.6% growth experienced last year. Their optimism is due to the strong growth in online sales, which are expected to increase between 8% and 12%. (NRF)
- California's unemployment rate continues to drop. The rate was at 4.9% in June, 0.7% under the 2016 rate for the same period. Total unemployment decreased by -11.5% during the same period, while labor force increased by 0.2%. (EDD)


### Sales Tax Per Capita by Benchmark Year
