## News

- E-Commerce as a Percent of Total U.S. Sales (3Q2019): 11.2\% in 3Q2019. 10.8\% in 2Q2019. 10.5\% in 1Q2019. 10.1\% in 4Q2018. 3Q2019 e-commerce estimate increased 5.0\% from 2Q2019 while total retail sales increased $1.4 \%$ in the same period. E-commerce sales in 3Q2018 accounted for $10.0 \%$ of total sales. (Census.gov)
- Holiday Spending: Retail sales rose $4.1 \%$ between August 1st and September 30th from a year ago. Total sales topped $\$ 875.8$ billion this year. Online sales continued to grow, up more than $13.7 \%$ from a year ago, Online sales made up $14.4 \%$ of total retail sales. (Census.gov)
- CA Labor Market: Unemployment rate dropped to $4.0 \%$ in September. The U.S. Unemployment Rate remained the same at $3.5 \%$ in August and decreased by $.2 \%$ to $3.5 \%$ in October. California's Labor Force Participation Rate rose by $0.1 \%$ in November, the state's highest rate since July 2013.(CA DOF)
