NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals for the work entitled:

SOUTHWEST PITTSBURG GEOLOGICAL HAZARD ABATEMENT DISTRICT
("GHAD DISTRICT") BI-ANNUAL WEED ABATEMENT

will be received by the City of Pittsburg at the front of City Hall, 65 Civic Avenue, First Floor, Pittsburg, California until 2:00 p.m. on September 29, 2021 at which time they will be opened and read aloud.

The work of this Contract consists in weed abatement and non-native plant species removal, twice a year on parcels owned and/or maintained by the GHAD District. This scope includes, but is not limited to, weed abatement and removal of non-native invasive plant species by means of mowing, rotary cutting, chain sawing, chemical control techniques and non-native plant species removal within the areas of GHAD open space and the Preserves and all other work necessary for a complete project in accordance with Request for Quotation.

Attention is directed to the provisions of Chapter 9 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code concerning the licensing of Contractors. All bidders or Contractors shall be licensed in accordance with the laws of the State of California and any bidder or Contractor not so licensed is subject to the penalties imposed by such laws.

There will be a pre-bid job walk for this Contract. On September 15, 2021, all bidders shall meet at 10:00 AM at the south end of San Marco Blvd for a pre-bid job walk. All interested bidders are encouraged to attend as there will be no other opportunities to be onsite in restricted areas included in the Project.

Inquiries or questions based on alleged patent ambiguity of the plans, specifications or estimate must be communicated as a bidder inquiry prior to bid opening. Questions received less than five (5) working days prior to the date for opening of proposals may not be answered and the lack of a response to such inquires or questions shall not be considered as a basis for a bid protest

Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing wage rates in the

county, or counties, in which the work is to be done have been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. These wages are set forth in the General Prevailing Wage Rates for this project, available at City of Pittsburg and available from the California Department of Industrial Relations' Internet web site at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD>.

Pursuant to Public Contracts Code Section 22300, a Contractor may (upon request and at its sole expense) substitute securities for any moneys withheld by the City to ensure performance of the work of this Contract. Any such substitution shall be in strict accordance with Public Contract Code Section 22300.



Each bidder, and any subcontractor listed in a bid proposal pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 4104, must be currently registered with the Department of Industrial Relations and qualified to perform public work consistent with Labor Code section 1725.5, except in limited circumstances as referenced in Labor Code section 1771.1(a). This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.
