

Proclamation

AMERICAN RED CROSS MONTH - MARCH 2024

WHEREAS, in honor of those that turn compassion into action, Red Cross month falls in the month of March; and

WHEREAS, the Red Cross society has been saving lives since the 1800s and is made up of volunteers who offer to help others in times of crisis; and

WHEREAS, according to statistics, the American Red Cross responds to an emergency every eight minutes which means that in every 24-hour period, the Red Cros responds to approximately 180 emergencies; and

WHEREAS, Red Cross Bay Area Chapter serves nearly 4.5 million people across the counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, San Francisco and San Mateo; and

WHEREAS, multiple atmospheric rivers impacted California last winter and spring, with severe weather that upended lives. Over 1,200 Red Cross workers supported safe refuge for displaced families and delivered vital supplies, financial assistance and more; and

WHEREAS, the Northern California Coastal Region Red Cross Home Fire Campaign was a success where 1,294 free smoke alarms were installed, 462 homes made safer, thanks to volunteers, local fire departments and partners; and

WHEREAS, each year, more than 120 students across the Bay Area gather for a transformative experience. The Red Cross Leadership Development Center, a four-day conference, empowers students with leadership skills and disaster preparedness; and

WHEREAS, we dedicate the month of March to the American Red Cross to support their mission to prevent and alleviate human suffering in the face of emergencies by mobilizing the power of volunteers and the generosity of donors.
