



Pittsburg Unified Seeks Names for new Continuation High School

Pittsburg Unified School District will open a new continuation high school in the fall of 2012. The school will be located on Stoneman Avenue. To begin the process of naming the new school, an invitation is being extended to the community to submit names for consideration. Forms are available on the district website at www.pittsburg.k12.ca.us or can be completed at 2000 Railroad Avenue, Pittsburg, Ca. 94565; and submitted to the Superintendent's Office. The School Naming Committee will share their recommendations with the School Board on June 8, 2011.

All forms must be submitted by Noon - Monday, May 23, 2011. The following criteria will be used in recommending a name:

1. After the geographical area.
2. After a figure, prominent in the history of the world, nation, state, or community.
3. After a person who has made significant contributions to the school system and to the community.
4. After a person who has been instrumental in the betterment of the nation, State or local community
5. To reflect the cultural diversity of the school district or the community.
