

PCT's Production of Laughter on the 23rd Floor Scheduled in May

Pittsburg Community Theatre's final production of their 2011-2012 Season, the comedy, "***Laughter on the 23rd Floor***" is scheduled for six performances in May.

Directed by Suzan Lorainne, the play is Neil Simon's homage to the glory days of television. The characters in the play are based on Simon's co-writers on Your Show Of Shows. Simon's alter-ego Lucas Brickman, maintains a running commentary on the writing, fighting, and wacky antics which take place in the writers' room. At the plot's core is Max's ongoing battles with NBC executives who fear his humor is too sophisticated for Middle America.
