Concerning the following matter: Establishing preferential residential permit parking in the area of Pittsburg Center BART Station

The City of Pittsburg adopted a City ordinance providing a framework to implement permit parking in City neighborhoods. Further, the City is considering a preferential residential permit parking (PRPP) program in neighborhoods included in the Pittsburg Center BART Station Parking Strategy & Implementation Plan. This program will enable residents of the neighborhood to receive permits that will allow them and their guests to park on the street on weekday mornings when parking will otherwise be restricted. By limiting the amount of on street parking that is available to commuter and other non-residents, the PRPP program will reduce noise, traffic hazards, litter, and air pollution. In addition, the program will encourage the use of car pools and public transit by restricting the use of on-street parking spaces by nonresidents, while making them available to resident commuters who want to leave their vehicles at home.

You are invited to submit comments regarding any aspect of this matter in writing or verbally at the public hearing. If you challenge the above matter in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing.
